Scope: The presenters representing projects will be asked to prepare a 10 minute presentation with focus on <u>DPP or tracing solution for selected sector/product</u> being developed within the project (including main challenges encountered in relation to the DPP development/implementation (e.g. ongoing legislation and standardization process, difficulties in collecting data, the accuracy of the data in the DPP, flows complexity), that could contribute to overall discussion towards defining strategies for addressing common challenges and aspects to consider in the transition towards a common approach.
